He studied art history at the University of Cologne, Germany and at the Academy of Fine Arts in Vienna. For more than 20 years he taught and lived in the USA, Europe and Eastern Europe. As a result, he is a founding member of the Levitt/Lubetkin/Massimino architectural firm. Over the years he has designed dozens of residential, residential/retail and commercial projects, many in historic preservation areas. Career Lubetkin received a BS in architecture from the

University of Cincinnati and a PhD in fine arts from the University of Vienna. His thesis was on the mediation of light in the architecture of the 18th century. After graduating in 1959, he worked for a while in the German Federal Republic with Hans Hollein, the first to introduce vinyl siding as a result of his influences on William Haines. He worked as a private architect and taught and lectured at the University of Illinois at Chicago, the Santa Barbara Graduate School of Education, the University of Chicago, and the University of California at Los Angeles. He has taught at schools in the USA and abroad, including Florence, Italy; Philadelphia, Italy; Barcelona, Spain; Vienna; and
